
**Futures Closes**

Grain futures closed higher today but well off of session highs. Trade opened higher last night and moved even higher into mid morning as clarification was made to POTUS' news conference yesterday citing China purchasing 5 mil mt/day of soybeans. It became clear the correct translation was an additional Chinese soybean purchase of 5 mil MT. CFTC has started releasing weekly COT "catch up" data. See page 5 for the estimated fund positions as of today Friday Feb 8, USDA will release the WASDE report including FINAL 18 crop numbers.



Comments from Arlan Suderman—FCStone

I figured there would be questions about what this is. So here you go.

I took the price from the Brazilian port in Santos and the US port in New Orleans. Then converted them both to USD per Bushel.

I then pulled the DAILY freight cost of both of these locations to North China. I converted this to USD per Bushel as well.

I then summed the Freight and the FOB Prices together to give me the cost delivered into North China.

Then I applied a 3% tariff and a 10% value added tax to all of the brazil numbers and US numbers prior to July  $6^{th}$ , 2018.


For all United States numbers after July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018. A 28% tariff and a 10% value added tax was added to the FOB value.
