

GERALD GRAIN CENTER KEN FREYTAG SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose:	The purpose of this scholarship endowment fund is to encourage qualified High School graduates to further their training in higher education. This scholarship was created in memory of Ken Freytag, who worked for Gerald Grain Center for 40 years before losing his battle with cancer. Ken had a drive for hard work and a passion for agriculture. Ken was a teacher and mentor to younger employees and this scholarship was created to allow more high school graduates to continue their education in Ken's memory.
Amount:	The amount to be awarded each year will be at least \$2,000.
Number of Scholarships:	The number of scholarships awarded each year will be at least 3. (1) \$1,000 and (2) \$500 scholarships. These scholarships will only be for one year. None will be renewable.
Eligibility:	The recipient shall be a senior currently enrolled in High School and has made application to and has been accepted into a college or university or equivalent advanced training institution on a full time basis. We are looking for candidates with a background in agriculture and will favor candidates going to an Ag related school or Ag related program.
Basis of Selection:	(1) Scholarship (seven semester GPA, transcript of courses taken, and ACT/SAT composite scores.) (2) School and non-school related activities. (3) The input of school officials will be considered. (4) Community service.
Time of Awards:	The applications must be returned to the Gerald Grain Center Main office by March 27, 2020. Gerald Grain Center, 14540 County Road U Napoleon, OH 43545
Mode of Payments:	The amount shall be paid directly to the student.
Responsibility of the Student:	This Scholarship is not a loan and does not require repayment as long as the student successfully completes the first year of college as a full time student.
Scholarship Committee:	<p>The committee will consist of Management from Gerald Grain Center and members of Ken Freytag's family.</p> <p>Their job is to receive, review, and rank all applications. A scholarship will be given to the top three applicants.</p> <p>The results will be given to the Gerald Grain Center Board of Directors who may award additional scholarships based on the rankings if money is available.</p>
