

**ELECTRONIC WAREHOUSE RECEIPT SIGNATURE AGREEMENT
AND POWER OF ATTORNEY**

THE UNDERSIGNED does hereby appoint **EARLY COUNTY GIN, INC.** of **EARLY** County, State of Georgia, (a Georgia licensed cotton warehouse or unlicensed ginner/agent) the attorney-in-fact to act for _____ (producer) in connection with the creation, negotiation and transfer of electronic warehouse receipts (hereinafter 'EWRS') for cotton. This is a limited power of attorney granted in conjunction with O.C.G.A. 10-4-19(a), and Rule 40-14-3-.05(2).

The undersigned producer hereby accepts electronic warehouse receipts and the use of electronic signatures.

The producer authorizes the attorney-in-fact to:

1. Obtain from Georgia approved Providers of EWRS, any necessary accounts, Holder IDs, PIN numbers, passwords and User IDs in or for my name for the purpose of EWR creation and title transfers.
2. Utilize any Provider computer program which automatically transfers EWRS to my Holder ID or PIN and thence to the Holder ID of said warehouseman, ginner or agent, who shall have full authority to be the Holder of those EWRS until such time of title transfer. By extension of this agreement any Provider is granted authority to automate such transfer; however, such extension is limited to automation of title transfer.
3. Transfer EWR titles to others on my behalf using such electronic signature representations as Holder IDs, PIN numbers and other necessary electronic representations.
4. Record bank liens on my EWRS.

Termination. This EWR Signature Agreement and Power of Attorney shall terminate upon receipt of written notice by either party provided that any previously authorized EWR title transfers of cotton have not been negotiated by the producer's authorized agent.
