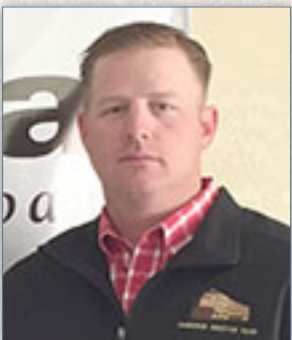

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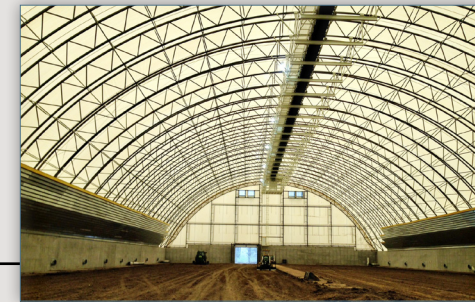
In June of 2008, The Scoular Company acquired the Hancock Elevator - a well established business with an environment dedicated to customer service.
