Dear Member,

A decision was made after two joint board meetings with the Board of Directors of Farmers Win Cooperative, Fredericksburg, IA and Farmers Coop Elevator, Rushford, MN, to enter into a study to determine if a merger of the cooperatives would be beneficial to their member-owners.

Through this analysis process we hope to determine that consolidating the two cooperatives would create value in the following ways:

- Create economies of scale to improve operating efficiencies, which in turn enhances our competitive advantage in the marketplace
- Enhance, expand and extend product service options, market access and risk management tools for members
- Improve access to capital for future investments required to meet the needs of our customers
- Provide opportunities for growth, training, and advancement of employees

The merger study will commence in September with the goal of bringing the findings to the members through informational meetings in November.

Headquartered in Fredericksburg Iowa, Farmers Win Coop is a 14 location cooperative servicing members and customers in northeast Iowa and southeast Minnesota. Services include grain, agronomy, feed, fuel and propane.
