

## Grain Settlement Policy

After grain has been priced and delivered, payment can be arranged for a number of different ways.

- Payment can be made by check from **Ag Valley Cooperative (AVC)** and picked up by the customer at any **AVC** location with check writing capabilities. These include, but are not always limited to:
  - Bartley, Edison, Eustis, Holbrook, Maywood, North Platte and Norton
- Payment can be mailed.
- Payment can be direct deposited into the bank account of our customer's choice via ACH. Prior to issuing payment, necessary paperwork must be completed.
- Payment or a portion of payment can be deferred to a later date. Please visit with your accountant regarding payments taken in another calendar year for potential income tax consequences.

Payment on completed direct-ship contracts will be made no sooner than the following business day the last load was delivered.

Please note – No payments will be issued until proper instructions have been given. **AVC** does not automatically send payment.

Special payment requests are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
