

USA Upland and Pima Export Sales and Shipments for Week Ending December 6, 2018

Current crop sales were 58,020 bales. Current crop PLUS new crop sales were 91,550 bales.

Current crop sales were down 51% from last week and down 63% from the 4-week average. Current PLUS new crop sales were down 54% from last week and down 55% from the 4-week average.

Shipments of Upland and Pima were 166,210 bales, which was 76% of expected seasonally-adjusted pace.

There are 34 weeks remaining in the 2018/19 marketing year.

To ship the USDA estimate of 15,000,000 bales for 2018/19 crop, the U.S. needs to average sales of 165,200 bales per week, and needs to average shipments of 354,800 bales per week.
