

USA Upland and Pima Export Sales and Shipments for Week Ending April 4, 2019

Current crop sales were 319,130 bales. Current crop PLUS new crop sales were 527,600 bales.

Current crop sales were down 6% from last week and up 37% from the 4-week average. Current PLUS new crop sales were up 8% from last week and up 60% from the 4-week average.

Shipments of Upland and Pima were 404,330 bales, which was 101% of expected seasonally-adjusted pace.

There are 17 weeks remaining in the 2018/19 marketing year.

To ship the USDA estimate of 15,000,000 bales for 2018/19 crop, the U.S. needs to average sales of 112,700 bales per week, and needs to average shipments of 410,700 bales per week.
