

WEEKLY EXPORT REPORT

USA Upland and Pima Export Sales and Shipments for Week Ending September 17, 2020

Net current crop sales were 111,200 bales. Net current crop PLUS new crop sales were 161,800 bales.

Sales returned to a more normal, and adequate level. Vietnam was the largest buyer (53,500) with China in second place (45,200). Shipments were up almost 100,000 bales from last week with China accounting for 40%.

Shipments of Upland and Pima were 294,870 running bales, which was 173% of expected seasonally-adjusted pace.

There are 46 weeks remaining in the 2020/21 marketing year.

To ship the USDA estimate of 14,600,000 (480 lb.) bales for 2020/21 crop, the U.S. needs to average sales of 168,500 bales per week, and needs to average shipments of 259,200 running bales per week.
