How Do I Control Grubs in My Lawn?


What are grubs? And what damage to they cause?



Grubs are frequently found feeding on the roots of turf and pasture grasses. The key symptom of grub invasion is irregular deed patches which will lift up easily if tugged on. The lawn may also have patches that have been burrowed in or been up-turned by moles, skunks or raccoons feeding on grubs. The highest concentration of grubs will be found in dead turf bordering green areas!

How Do I Control Them?

Ontario's Cosmetic Pesticide ruled out use of chemicals. Enter the beneficial nematode! These microscopic sized bullies can tackle and help reduce or eliminate your grub problem!
