New Bagger – Orangeville Location

At the end of October, we installed a new heat-sealed bagger at our Orangeville location. With this, we have switched to heat-sealed bags rather than the open valve bags and a new label printer on the bag line as well. The label printer allows us to fully customize the bag labels and helps reduce waste from previously using stickers, ribbon ink and paper. The label printer can print up to 60,000 bags (equiv. to approx. 2,400 MT) before a new cartridge is needed. In addition, the new system helps reduce the dust while the bag is being filled with fertilizer, and there is a reduction in noise too. The new bagger allows us to bag 3-4 times faster than our previous system which has increased our productivity greatly!

Grower Pesticide Update

We have dates set for the new year for the Grower Pesticide Safety Refresh and Rewrite at the Orangeville and Stayner locations. Please have a look at your existing cards and make plans for renewal. Safety measures for COVID-19 will be enforced at these events. Effective January 1st, 2021, pesticides that were in Class 4, such as some rodenticide or glyphosate products are now in Class C in Ontario and will require proper certification to purchase. Please make sure you have this in place before the upcoming year.
