From the Desk of the Agronomists: Online Dicamba Training

This is a yearly requirement for anyone handling dicamba for use in soybeans; training is offered online through chemical companies and the extension. The following are some links to the course and you will also need to provide proof of training to retailers. It is required for all handlers and those making the application. Dicamba is a challenging product that requires additional record keeping versus all other ag chemicals.
