

# Average Pricing Program


Let us know how many bushels you would like to enroll by the end of May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

An equal percentage of bushels will be priced every trade day, from May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2018 in order to come up with an "Average Price" during the summer.

There will be no service fee charged for this contract.

It's easy to look back over time and see that historically the best time to market forward corn early spring through early summer. However, when you factor in the emotion of a weather market and the uncertainty of production at that time, it's also one of the most difficult times to "pull the trigger."

- This seasonal pricing program simply aims to achieve an average price over an 10 week period of time which historically yields the highest prices.
- In a diversified marketing approach having a small percentage of production priced in this emotionally-charged period of time makes sense.
- In looking at long term seasonal price patterns the peak of the growing season for corn and soybeans prove quite often to be higher than the fall values.
- Historical price patterns are not a guarantee of future price movements



Marketing your crop during the uncertain growing season can be difficult, but it often yields the best returns historically. This program helps put the odds in your favor!
