US Sample Grade:				
1. Does not meet the requirements for the grades US Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5; or				
2. Has a musty, sour or commercially objectionable foreign odor, or				
3. Is heating or otherwise of distinctly low quality.				

Broken corn and foreign material - All matter that passes readily through a 12/64 round-hole sieve and all matter other than corn that remains in the sieved sample after sieving according to procedures prescribed in FGIS instructions.

Damaged kernels - Kernels and pieces of corn kernels that are badly ground-damaged, badly weather-damaged, diseased, frost-damaged, germ-damaged, heat-damaged, insect-bored, mold-damaged, sprout-damaged or otherwise materially damaged.

Heat-damaged kernels - Kernels and pieces of corn kernels that are materially discolored and damaged by heat.

Moisture Requirements - 15.0 on *Sell* or *Contract* : 14.0 on *Delayed Price* : 14.0 on *Storage*

Dry & Return - Must be hauled home immediately or incur .15 cents/bushel charge.

There will be punitive damages for any grain contaminated with treated seed

There are various discounts for each grain that is not included on this sheet, but are still applicable when determining grain values.

The elevator reserves the right to reject loads of distinctly low quality or that have not been loaded uniformly.

These discounts are subject to change at any time.
