

IN THE FIELD WITH UFC.....

With the 2015 growing season upon us Waterhemp control seems to be a major topic of concern in soybean production. To control Waterhemp a pre-emergence herbicide seems to be most effective. At United Farmers Coop we believe that using the following recommendations will help keep Waterhemp under control. Fierce herbicide (Flumioxazin, Pyroxasulfone) @ 3oz seems to have worked great in the past. Fierce herbicide with adequate rainfall will provide 4-6 weeks of grass and broadleaf control. This program also qualifies for a \$3/acre rebate when paired with Roundup brand glyphosates.

Another popular option has been Prowl @ 3 pts./acre either alone or in combination with Metribuzin. This can be applied ahead of planting after leveling last Fall's tillage. Incorporation needs to take place if no rainfall is received 5-7 days after application.
