Guidelines and Application

Graduating high school seniors pursuing an agricultural-related major at any two - or four-year college are encouraged to apply for one of six \$1,000 Viafield Ag Youth Scholarships.

Student Eligibility

- · High school senior, graduating in the spring
- Must intend to major in agriculture
- Legal U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- The student or the parent of the student must be a patron member of Viafield
- Students of Viafield Team Members who are Class A and Class B coop members in good standing
