US Sample Grade:
 1. Does not meet the requirements for the grades US Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5; or
 2. Has a musty, sour or commercially objectionable foreign odor, or
 3. Is heating or otherwise of distinctly low quality

Broken corn and foreign material- All matter that passes readily through a 12/64 round-hole sieve and all matter other than corn that remains in the sieved sample after sieving according to procedures prescribed in FGIS instructions.

Damaged kernels- Kernels and pieces of corn kernels that are badly ground-damaged, badly weather-damaged, diseased, frost damaged, germ-damaged, heat-damaged, insect-bored, mold-damaged, sprout-damaged or otherwise materially damaged.

Heat-damaged kernels- Kernels and pieces of corn kernels that are materially discolored and damaged by heat.

Moisture Requirements- 14.5 on *Sell* or *Contract*: 14.5 on *Delayed Price*: 14.5 on *Storage*

There are various discounts for each grain that are not included in this sheet, but are still applicable when determining grain values. Wheaton-Dumont Coop Elevator reserves the right to reject loads of distinctly low quality or that have not been loaded uniformly.
