INDOT Traffic Standards Update

- Sinusoidal Rumble Stripes



- Draft Update to 808-T-190d is in development
- Will use 12 in. sine curve wavelength
- Make adjustments for bicycle gaps
- Add a sheet for shoulder rumble strips for wider shoulders

- Temporary Edge Lines

- Will likely add guidance to Design Manual
- No spec changes at this time



INDOT Traffic Standards Update

- Portable Signals



- NEMA TS-5 Standard for Portable Signals published 5/19/2017
- Update to ITM 956 in development

INDOT Traffic Standards Update

- Highway Lighting Conversion (HPS to LED)



- Three year conversion process planned starting in 2018
- Greenfield District goes first (T-40681)

INDOT Traffic Standards Update

- Reminders – Effective with September 2017 Lettings
 - Temporary Mounted Construction Signs: roll-up materials now allowed for short-term work up to one daylight period.
 - Detour Signs: cardinal direction auxiliary signs are now required (except for detours on one-way streets).
 - Fluorescent Yellow Sheeting: required on all warning signs (except for fluorescent yellow-green on bike/ped signs).
 - Panel Signs: standards for ground mounted panel signs now require larger beams and foundations.
