INDOT Update – Boruff/Kachler/McGregor

- Adoption of use of BLACK Temp Tape.
- Fluorescent Orange sheeting required on drums and tubular markers after September, 2019.
- INDOT is reviewing the time period for contractors to remove signage is extended from 5 days to 10 days. Approval is anticipated.
- Developing specs to cover digital sign printing
- Opening specs up to red/yellow lens type for automated flaggers
- Working on specs for temp traffic signals and AFAD devices
- Considering using durable pavement markings more
- Looking to set aside funding to replace overhead sign structures
- Staff changes at the Workzone Safety Section
- Major concerns with temporary work zone speed limits with implementation and signage
- Concerns with Construction Clear Zone, protecting blunt ends of concrete barrier and storing equipment behind the barriers
- Feedback on Temporary Portable Rumble Strips moving and shifting when left out 24/7. INDOT setting up cameras and reviewing jobs.
- Focusing on doing meaningful work zone reviews.
- Looking into coming up with a nighttime work zone lighting policy.
- Communication will be a big focus for the Work Zone Safety group.

ICI Update – Dan Osborn

- Funding – sales tax for next year, 2019 construction plan is \$1,008,000,000. 4 hefty lettings to start the year.
- Hoping for some more substantial work for next year.
- \$190,000,000 increase based on tolls coming up in the next few years.
- Work Zone Safety discussion in committees.
- Full closures on a number interstate of jobs have been successful and more in the plans.
- Discussion of use of tubular markers, when and where.
- Discussion on Arrow Boards pay items going from day to lump sum.
- New electronic process on contractor evaluations have been in use of a couple of years.
