#### Abbreviated staff summary

The Rocky Mountain ATSSA Chapter met on November 7, 2018 at the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) in Denver, CO. There were 27 people in attendance, including representatives from CDOT, City of Boulder, Douglas County, and the City of Fort Collins.

Guest speakers, Charles Meyers and Natasha Crayton from CDOT, provided an update on the work group that has been formed to address the roles of traffic control supervisors and flaggers. The work group is comprised of representatives from RM-ATSSA, Colorado Contractors Association and other external industry partners, with the goal of developing a career path that would attract and retain qualified workers within the traffic control industry. Thus far, it has been determined that a more experienced flagger is needed on some jobs and there might be a use for ATSSA's traffic control technician training, which is not currently required in Colorado. Jessica Scheyder, ATSSA's director of training, agreed to share the traffic control technician curriculum with CDOT as they continue to determine the best path in providing quality safety training for employees.

Chapter members elected Shawn Severin as president-elect, and Joe Brandt, Rick Brown, Luann Leiding and Chad Palmer as directors to serve the RM-ATSSA chapter. Ted Ott was thanked for his service as chapter president for the past two years, and will continue serving on the Board as immediate past president. Shane Tisdall assumed the role of president beginning November 2018 through 2020.

The next Chapter meeting will be held on Thursday, January 17, 2019 with the location to be determined.
