Chartered by the International Baccalaureate Organization in 2006, the I.B. Program at NSFZ is the first at a government-run school in the People's Republic of China. The program offers three years of study culminating in an I.B. Diploma for qualifying students. The faculty includes experienced educators from Great Britain, the United States, Canada, Australia, China and etc. All students plan to enroll at a college or university in the English-speaking world.

The School

Founded in 1902, High School Affiliated to Nanjing Normal University is one of the most selective schools in Jiangsu Province, which is home to approximately 75 million residents. The school enrolls approximately 6,000 high-school students on two campuses. Of the 60,000 prospective applicants that take the Nanjing High School Entrance Exam each year, only about top10 percent have the opportunity to get admitted. Known by the abbreviation NSFZ, which stands for "Nanjing Shida Fu Zhong" in Chinese, the school is designated by the nation Jiangsu provisional government as a Key School and one of the 10 Model Schools of Chinese Fundamental Education. Its teachers, many of whom have advanced degrees, consistently win provincial awards for teaching excellence. The vast majority of graduates attend leading universities in China, but approximately 8 percent choose to enroll abroad.

An International Vision

The school is firmly committed to the goals and ideals of International Baccalaureate, with special emphasis on encouraging students to interact with teachers and fellow students. Students are taught to appreciate varying points of view, and to value diversity in an increasingly international world.

Policy On Editing Of Student Essays

Every graduate of the I.B. program will have studied English throughout his or her school career, with the final three years of instruction exclusively in English. Almost all students in the Class of 2015 are fluent speakers, but none are native speakers. We believe that college application essays should reflect the students' ability to write in English. While we have given students general advice about writing their essays, we have refrained from editing their grammar and word choice.

Policy On Language Test Preparation

To maintain an orderly feasibility and guarantee the school practice of IBDP meets I.B. requirement both in level and study period, it's NSFZIB's policy that the school won't approve the request from any student or parent that they leave school even for a single day, attending public language proficiency test crash course in school days. We do not provide language proficiency test courses along with IBDP courses. All language proficiency test preparation shall be done in students' spare time. We encourage our students to plan ahead and learn to balance between IBDP and TOEFL, SAT or other.

Regardless of how many weeks, months other schools are allowing their students for language proficiency test preparation, students and parents are not to use that excuse requesting their leave.
