

OVERVIEW

- Personal Injury litigation is all about the numbers
- Defendants MUST understand how much money is at risk
- This presentation focuses on the four keys to preparing persuasive damage assessments and will demonstrate how spreadsheet software can be used to develop *flexible* assessments

KEY MESSAGE

- While most personal injury lawyers have developed their own effective protocol for presenting damage assessments they remain unable to accurately alter their assessments during the course of a fast paced negotiation
- Spreadsheets are needed to instantaneously recalculate damage assessments when concessions are made or assumptions are undermined during negotiations (calculators won't do)

FOUR KEYS TO PERSUASIVE DAMAGE ASSESSMENTS

A persuasive damage assessment must be:

- 1) Accurate
- 2) Concise
- 3) Understandable
- 4) Flexible*

ACCURATE

- Must properly calculate:
 - Prejudgment interest
 - Discount rates
 - Life expectancies
- Must properly apply:
 - Contributory negligence reductions
 - > Statutory deductibles, if applicable
- Must be precisely calculated to the date of resolution/trial

CONCISE

Must be on 1 or at most 2 pages

Must clearly show the grand totals

Must be comprehensive and cover all claims and heads of damage

UNDERSTANDABLE

- Must clearly identify assumptions such as:
 - Retirement Age
 - Life expectancy
 - Contributory negligence reductions
 - Duration of need for future care

FLEXIBLE

- Must be <u>capable of being amended</u> during the course of a mediation or pre-trial <u>to</u> <u>instantaneously address concessions</u>
- Must be able to instantaneously recalculate and present the NEW persuasive damage assessment while meeting the other criteria of being accurate, concise and understandable
- This is the item that is often overlooked and leads to miscalculations and poor estimates!

USING SPREADSHEETS TO PRESENT PERSUASIVE DAMAGE ASSESSMENTS

- Spreadsheets programs, like Excel, are essentially sophisticated calculators
- Spreadsheet programs can be used to prepare damage assessment summaries
- Spreadsheets <u>allow for easy</u> <u>manipulation of figures and</u> <u>assumptions</u>

USING SPREADSHEETS TO PRESENT PERSUASIVE DAMAGE ASSESSMENTS

- Spreadsheet programs, like the Personal Injury Damages Calculator, can be used to persuasively:
 - 1) Illustrate the possible value of your case at the outset to help establish reserves
 - 2) Present evolving damage assessments
 - 3) Calculate the present value of future care cost reports and of various income loss scenarios

- Use spreadsheets to add flexibility to damage assessments
- Preparing accurate, concise, understandable and <u>flexible</u> damage assessments will lead to consistently improved results
