

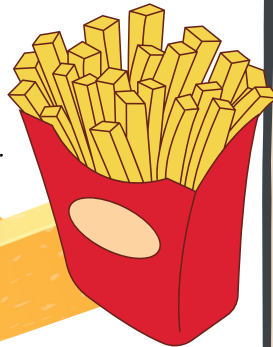
DEAR PARENTS,
