1) Everywhere God sends you on assignment, He has given you authority in that region

a) Mark 16:15-18

b) Luke 9:1-6

c) Luke 10:1-12 (Instructions) 17-20 (report)

d) Joshua 1:3 (NKJV) <sup>3</sup> Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses.

e) 36:35 (NKJV) <sup>35</sup> So they will say, 'This land that was desolate has become like the garden of Eden; and the wasted, desolate, and ruined cities *are now* fortified *and* inhabited.'

f) Acts 8:4-8 (NKJV): Christ was preached in Samaria: Philip was used mightily in healings and miracles. People heeded what he said and came to know Jesus Christ as their savior.

g) Acts 8:14-18: Peter and John sent to minister the Baptism of the Holy Spirit to Samaria after Philip preached Christ to them.

h) Acts 9:36-43: Dorcas (translated as Tabitha), a woman full of good works and charitable deeds fell sick and died. Peter came, put people (negative and distractions) out of the room, knelt and prayed and Dorcas rose up.

2) Everywhere that you preach the Kingdom of God, there will be a change to align with Kingdom Principles.

a) Luke 4:43 – Jesus came and preached the Kingdom of God and we must preach the Kingdom of God in every area of our lives.

1) The Kingdom of God comes with Authority! That authority is in the Gospel of the Kingdom of God which Jesus preached.

2) Mark 1:15: “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the gospel.”

3) Romans 1:16-17 (NKJV) For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. (17) For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “The just shall live by faith.”

a) Power of God: dunamis *doo'-nam-is* From **G1410**; *force* (literally or figuratively); specifically *miraculous power* (usually by implication a *miracle* itself): - ability, abundance, meaning, might (-ily, -y, -y deed), (worker of) miracle (-s), power, strength, violence, mighty (wonderful) work. Total KJV occurrences: 120

b) Salvation: sōtēria *so-tay-ree'-ah* Feminine of a derivative of **G4990** as (properly abstract) noun; *rescue* or *safety* (physically or morally): - deliver, health, salvation, save, saving. Total KJV occurrences: 45

c) Luke 4:14-30. (Illustration people as the roadblock) Emphasis Verse 29-30. Everything that Satan brings against you is so that you would not see and accept your position in the kingdom of God. Anxiety, hurt, pain, pressure from job, pressure from people, sickness, disease can relate to the people in the city who wanted to thrust Jesus off the cliff, but when they tried, he went through the middle of them to the other side. You've got to preach the Gospel of the kingdom of God to yourself, within your situation and to your destiny to come out and stand on top of our enemy in victory!

d) Romans 8:11: But if the Spirit of Him who raised Christ from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.”

## 2. Influence

a. Matthew 28:19 (NKJV) <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

1) Nations: Ethnos: every culture, every custom every race.

b. Mark 16:15 (NKJV) <sup>15</sup> And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

1) World: Kosmos: anything ordered. political or social systems.

1) Joseph. Genesis 41:37-44

2) Paul – Acts 21:11 (Prophecy – Agabus: Paul will be bound by the Jews and taken to the Gentiles)

a) Romans 9:17 (Exodus 9:16) Purpose of Paul being arrested was so that he could be taken to stand before Ceasar

b) Acts 23:11: Acts 23:11 (NKJV)<sup>11</sup> But the following night the Lord stood by him and said, “Be of good cheer, Paul; for as you have testified for Me in Jerusalem, so you must also bear witness at Rome.”

### 3. Execution Phase

a) 2 Kings 6:8-17 (Syrians captured, Elisha prays that his servants eyes are open to the Angelic Host with them)

b. Maintain your victory.

1) Strengthen your weakness and strategize prayer points to overcome and take back the enemies territories that he has been given “legal right by our actions an confessions”. Reverse the curse and living in the blessings of God.
