Word Spoken to Pastor Randy by the Lord on February 28, 2018: Living Faith Christian Center, Tucson International will be a place where the Supernatural becomes the Natural!

Genesis 1:26, John 14:21-16; Psalm 22:3, Psalm 116:92

God is looking for a place where the Supernatural is the Natural. He is looking for a place where there is a hunger for His glory to come and live.

2 Timothy 3:1-5

The church was never meant to be a social club, it was meant to be a body of believers with like same Faith coming together to experience the glory of god collectively as a whole. .

God's supernatural power was never meant to be inclusive to a select few but to be inclusive to all who believe.

John 14:21: Jesus said He would manifest Himself to those who believe.

Belief in Jesus Christ and His resurrection along with acceptance = us to be His image in Genesis 1:26 which enables us and legally guarantees us to live supernaturally naturally.

Ephesians 2:8-10

Jesus is the image of God and I become like Jesus. The more I believe in Jesus Christ and submit to his commands, the more I respond to his words which releases the power of God to work supernaturally.

Invite the Holy Spirit to be part of what's happening.

1 Corinthians 12:4-11.

The Holy Spirit can use anyone as He wills!

The moment one gives his or her life to Jesus Christ and makes him their Lord and Savior, and commits to following after Him and keeping His commandments, that person has just stepped out of the natural and into the supernatural!
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Introduction

There are 2 major realms of life: 1) natural , 2) supernatural. The **natural realm** is the dimension that is subject of the laws of time, space and matter. This realm can be accessed only through the physical senses – sight, hearing, touch, taste and smell. The **supernatural realm** or the **spiritual realm**, is the dimension that operates above natural laws. It is permanent, invisible, and eternal located outside of time and it exercises dominion over the natural realm.

- 2 Corinthians 4:18 (NKJV) ¹⁸ while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen *are* temporary, but the things which are not seen *are* eternal. (**supernatural realm**)

It was never God's intention to remain a mystery to His people. He has always desired for us to know Him intimately and to experience His attributes, strengths and virtues. Only God can reveal God.

The only way to know God is through revelation. In the Greek, the word revelation means "apokalypsis" when means an uncovering or disclosure. Revelation enables us to understand truths about the spiritual realm.

How do we receive revelation from God by His spirit? We are made up of three parts: spirit (the essence of our being created in the image of God); soul mind, will and emotions) and body. (1 Thessalonians 5:23; Genesis 1:26)

Revelation is the knowledge of God revealed to our spirits, and it is received by spiritually seeing, hearing and perceiving. This process is known as "spiritual perception." (2 Timothy 3:16 & 2 Peter 1:21)

Jesus called the Holy Spirit the "Spirit of Truth" (John 16:13) The Spirit is the only channel through which we have access to God's revealed wisdom and knowledge. The Holy Spirit makes known to men and women on earth what has been expressed by God in heaven. This happens at the moment one is "born again." (John 3:3-8)

3 Simple ways to move beyond the natural realm:

- ✓ By exercising our faith in God, through which we enter into the spiritual realm.
- ✓ By receiving revelation, or revealed knowledge, from God through the Holy Spirit.
- ✓ By applying our faith once more, in response to the revelation, activating God's supernatural power on or behalf , or on behalf of others.

The supernatural realm is the realm where miracles occur.

- 1 Corinthians 4:20 (NKJV) ²⁰ For the kingdom of God *is* not in word but in power.

The truth of the bible can be properly expressed only by using the language of the bible, while also demonstrating its power. God can be known and understood only by faith and revelation, not logic or human perception.

Sermon Body

Main Text: John 14:21

John 14:21 (NKJV) ²¹ **He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."**

Jesus said that He will MANIFEST Himself to those who have His commandments and keep them. Jesus said that those who love Me will be loved by the Father and Jesus will love them and manifest Himself to them.

The word Manifest means **emphanizō em-fan-id'-zo** From G1717; to exhibit (in person) or disclose (by words): - appear, declare (plainly), inform, (will) manifest, shew, signify. Total KJV occurrences: 10

This is exactly what happened to Saul on the road to Damascus. Acts 9: 1-9. (Notice after Paul preached Christ immediately he was the son of God, Galatians 1:17-18)

Let's go to Exodus:

- a. How did God manifest to Moses? Burning Bush: Exodus 3:1-10. (Burning Bush)
- b. How did God manifest to the people who came out of Egypt: Exodus 13:21 (Cloud by day and fire by night)

If God manifested Himself supernaturally to His people in the Old Testament and Jesus manifested Himself after His death in the New Testament to Paul, His disciples and the 500 who gave witness to His resurrection, don't you think that God still wants to manifest Himself supernaturally to us today?

What we have today continually they did not have in the Old Testament

- a. They did not have the Father making his home within them as we have in John 15:21
- b. They did not have the continual, perpetual interaction of the Holy Spirit as we do today.

What's the Holy Spirit's purpose? John 16:13: "However, when He, the spirit of truth has come, he will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority but whatever he hears He will speak, and He will tell you things to come."

When did He come? Acts 1:8 foretold Acts 2:1-4

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The Holy Spirit's job is to lead us into all truth! That truth is to demonstrate the power of God Supernaturally in the Natural. The more I believe and respond, the more I can receive, experience and demonstrate the love that God has for us.

- Look at Ephesians 1:13-14; 17-18-19(NKJV) ¹³ In Him you also *trusted*, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, ¹⁴ who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory. ¹⁷ that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ¹⁸ the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what *is* the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power
- Ephesians 2:4–7 (NKJV) ⁴ But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, ⁵ even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶ and raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus, ⁷ that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
- Romans 5:8 (NKJV) ⁸ But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Everything about God is a demonstration! When God brought the Hebrew Children out of Egypt, He demonstrated it. When God led them in the desert, He demonstrated it. When God delivered His children from The Syrians, Assyrians and all the “hites” in the bible, He demonstrated it. In the New Testament, when God showed us his love, He demonstrated it by sending His son to die for us, deliver us, heal us and strengthen us. When God wanted His children to live and walk in power, He sealed us with the Holy Ghost and gave us “spiritual gifts” in 1 Corinthians 12:4-11. He demonstrated it.

The Supernatural Love and Power of God is about DEMONSTRATION! It's not just about knowledge. Knowledge can become a form of a “god” if not careful. One can begin worshiping knowledge versus worshiping the creator. The Creator gives us the knowledge about His riches and inheritance in us, His power, His glory, His supernatural ability so that we, His children, would want, desire and seek after Him and in doing so, we begin following the cycle that expresses the supernatural power of God: Father showed the Son, the Son showed the Holy Ghost, the Holy Ghost showed His children what to do and we follow the Holy Ghost. When we believe and confess that Jesus is Lord of our lives, we are tapping into the Supernatural Power of God that He wants all His children to experience! He wants to Demonstrate to this present age His Supernatural Power for US to live and experience continually!

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We must enter into the experience of knowing God in the spiritual realm in order to recognize and walk in the supernatural power.
