Noise

What the world needs is more silence. Reverent silence. In response to foolish idolatry, Habakkuk 2:20 says, "The Lord is in His holy temple; let all the earth keep silence before Him."

Noise, wretched, worldly noise should have no place in life.

There is the noise of false doctrine. "If any man speaks, let him speak as it were the oracles of God" (I Peter 4:11). In religion, if it's not the word of God, then it's nothing but noise. To teach a different doctrine is to "promote speculations" (I Timothy 1:3,4). The unfaithful are "empty talkers and deceivers" (Titus 1:10). They "upset whole families...speaking things which they ought not" (Titus 1:11). This is noise which must be stopped by gospel teaching.

There is the noise of hate. Love, true love, coming only from God (I Corinthians 13:4-8; I John 4:7,8), consisting of patience, kindness, respect and truth, is most precious. Anything done without love is useless, even if one sacrifices his own life for another (I Cor.13:2,3). And, this from Paul, "If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal" (I Cor.13:1).

There is the noise of self. Self-promotion, self-presentation...my thoughts, my experience, my looks. Yet, Peter writes, "let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious" (I Peter 3:4).

Silence is needed. More hearing God's word and less talking, less anger (James 1:19-21); more thanksgiving and less sin, less sarcasm (Eph.5:3-5) - these are the pressing needs. "Be still and know that I am God" (Psalm 46:10).
