A CULTURE OF EVANGELISM

Cambridge Dictionary defines "culture" as **"the way of life of a particular people, esp. as shown in their ordinary behavior and habits, their attitudes toward each other, and their moral and religious beliefs."** Nations have culture. Regions have culture. Even congregations of the Lord's church have culture.

As we have been discussing this year, we have a responsibility to look inward. As individuals, we have to examine ourselves. The same is true for our congregation. What kind of culture does the Midway congregation have?

To the point we want to make, does the Midway church have a culture of evangelism? There is no question that God mandated that His people meet together on the first day of the week to worship Him and encourage one another (cf. Acts 20:7, 1 Cor. 16:1-2; Heb. 10:25, etc). However, God never intended the extent of Christianity be Christians meeting with Christians!

What God did intend is that those who have learned the Gospel share what they have learned by teaching other people. God's plan for spreading the Gospel to the lost is through His church. Part of His plan includes sending missionaries. But His plan more directly involves individual Christians taking the Gospel everywhere they go (Acts 8:4) and teaching others who will continue to repeat the process (2 Tim. 2:2).

As a congregation, we must have a desire, a determination, and a plan to be evangelistic both at home and abroad. As a congregation, we must be encouraging each other as individuals to have a desire, a determination, and a plan to be evangelistic.

Be thinking about what we can do to continue to develop and encourage a greater culture of evangelism here at Midway. Remember that by looking inward, we are forced to also look outward!
