OFF TO LYNCHBURG!

Our annual youth campaign begins this Friday! DON'T LOSE YOUR TRADEMARK

Would you ever think that success in sales could create danger for a company? This occurs when a product becomes connected in the public mind with the whole class of that product, which includes competing brands.

Examples of this problem, which the Trademark Association calls "genericide," are numerous. All facial tissues may be called "kleenex." Gelatin dessert is "jell-o." A cold drink may be termed a "coke." Any adhesive bandage will be called a "band-aid." When I was a small boy, we put leftover food in our "frigidare, even though the refrigerator was another brand.

By becoming well-known

a product may lose its distinctiveness. In part, this has happened to the word "Christian." Once a brand name for a definite product, it is now loosely used by the world for any kind of vague religiosity.

A Christian is one who has obeyed the Gospel of Christ. This includes: belief in Christ as God's Son (John. 3:16) as well as baptism in water for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 2:38). A Christian is one whose life is governed by the Bible. The lifestyle of a Christian should stand out. It should not be confused with any other product (Philippians 2:15). Don't lose your trademark!
