In an effort to ensure accurate and consistent understanding of terminology found within these modules we want to stress the following definitions;

Native Language (Part C) is the language normally used by the individual, or, in the case of a child, the language normally used by the parents of the child. Section 303.25 (a)(2)

Native Language (Part B) is the language normally used by the child in home or learning environments. Section 300.29 (a)(2)

Native language, when used with respect to an individual who is deaf or hard of hearing, blind or visually impaired, or for an individual with no written language, means the mode of communication that is normally used by the individual (such as sign language, braille, or oral communication).

Home Language- Is the language most frequently spoken in the home setting.
