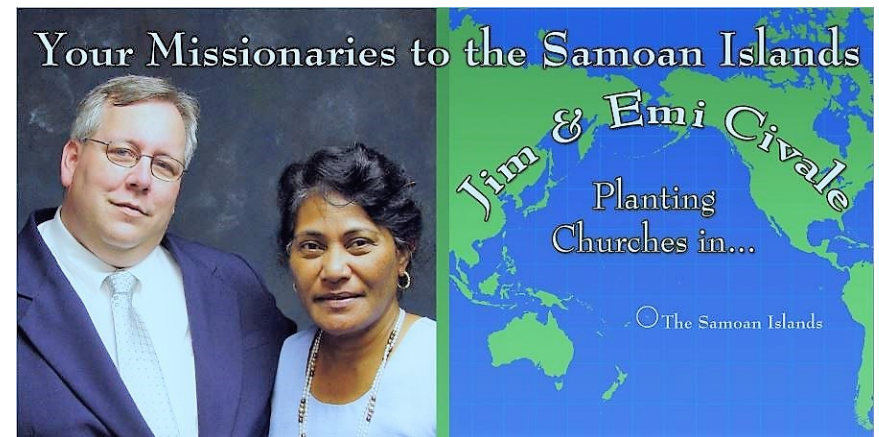
PRAYER
