Montgomery Baseball League (MBL) is pleased to announce new programs for 2015 in partnership with Montgomery High School (MHS) and Varsity Baseball Coach Pete Mueller and Junior Varsity Coach Steve Perone. Building upon years of shared success, MBL will host Coach Mueller, Coach Perone, and the MHS Cougars for several exciting events:

- **Coaches Clinic (March 20th):** Coach Mueller will conduct a free clinic to continue to advance the development of the managers and coaches in the MBL program.
- **MHS Hit-a-Thon (April 19<sup>th</sup>):** Come watch the MHS players “swing for the fences” in their annual MHS Baseball fundraiser (Rain Date: April 26<sup>th</sup>).
- **Recreational Ball Player Development Clinics (April 27<sup>th</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>):** Coach Mueller, his staff, and current MHS players will join MBL players (grades 3 and above) at McKnight Complex to conduct free workouts and training for all MBL players registered for our 2015 recreational baseball season.
- **Two (2) MHS Varsity Home Games at MBL’s McKnight Complex Field H (May 8<sup>th</sup> and May 15<sup>th</sup>):** Come watch several MBL alumni return “home” for a great game under the lights.

  - **May 15<sup>th</sup> – Hamilton at Montgomery**
- **Summer “Futures” Camp (July 13<sup>th</sup> thru July 16<sup>th</sup>):** Coach Mueller, his coaches, and his players will conduct a 4-day baseball camp at MBL’s McKnight Complex that will be open to kids of all ages.

In addition, MBL will offer its **3<sup>rd</sup> Annual 2015 MBL College Scholarship Program**. This program is open to all MBL alumni and provides scholarship awards to assist qualified and deserving baseball-player-applicants attending institutions of higher learning. Each award will be designed for one school year. MBL intends to once again award individual scholarships with a value of up to \$1,500. This program was first announced in March 2013 with our first candidate selected in June 2013.
