- Meeting convened: 7:02pm Motion to approve Feb. minutes by Brett, 2nd by Tom. Approved.
- Treasurer's report Ed: Numbers look good, balance higher than this time last year due to
 increase in registration fees. Ed researching places to store all documents that is safe, secure
 and accessible. Google docs suggested. Lee said this would be a good place to store all
 Secretary documentation as well. Brian asked if umpire payment system would remain as it did
 last year. Yes. Brian needs to give umpire company Ed Gullison's email.
- Registration update Lorraine: 75 softball players, 93 Babe Ruth, 148 11/12's, 156 9/10's, 108
 Rookies (30 try-ups). Troy noted that East Kingston did not have enough U8 players to form a
 team at that level in the Seacoast Softball League. He or Don Perrault will reach out to see if they
 want to join EJBL. More scholarships awarded this year than any previous year: 8 full, 5 partial.

- Uniform update Todd: to be picked up Wed., 3/14 and distributed at draft night.
- Apparel update Troy: As requested board members placed orders to test Coed Sportswear's ability to deliver products as promised. Some orders have not been received, some took 3 weeks. Keith motioned not to promote Coed Sportswear on our website, Bob 2nd. All in favor with no abstentions. Jeff J will call Don Lane to let him know.
- Coach's clinic 3/24 at coaches meeting –Tom: Jeff J, Brett & Tom will run through warm-ups/drills for coaches to keep consistent throughout all levels.
- EJBL Appreciation Day at Dick's March 24 11-4, need volunteers to man table from11 4pm; Troy will email asking for volunteers
- Fundraising Lee: raffle sale locations have been secured, fewer days granted than previous years. Tickets have been purchased. Hoping to have game schedules secured but coaches meeting to have coaches pick sales dates then.

- Field Day Jay: Sat., March 31st, raindate 4/1; Jay will make checklist & email date to league. Jay & Nat Hawkins are applying for volunteers to come from PEA. Currier needs a larger dumpster. Jeff will order larger size.

- Ed's Playoff suggestion Ed: discussed changing current playoff schedule to be 2 weeks long and be double elimination. Recognized that it's too late in the season for this year, tabled until next year.
- Sponsors update Brett: 6-8 new this year; Exeter Hospital requested online advertising, all agreed since they paid for the new sign that we'd give them free online advertising.
- Chose League Coordinators: Majors: John Brescia, AAA: pending; AA: Jay; A: Keith.
- Scheduling Bob: this year practice to be organized by asking coaches for their top 2 requests and Bob will try to accommodate. Jay to send Bob field reps names for all towns for scheduling.
- Babe Ruth Jeff D: From email dated March 4th from Troy to board members:
 - "Current Great Bay BR President Mike Sack is stepping down and there is no replacement. Organization has been poor for several years. Due to this leadership void, Oyster River has already pulled out of the league and joined Barrington.

After careful review, we recommend the following:

- Exeter charter as its own Babe Ruth league
- We treat this as a pilot for the upcoming season after which we can evaluate.
- Exeter can invite the other GB teams to join us in our new league (Sanborn, Stratham, Northwood, Newmarket)

The primary advantages:

- Disband a dysfunctional Great Bay organization
- Obtain more direct control over our Babe Ruth affairs

The impact to EJBL is minimal:

- BR Coordinator moderate impact as role grows to include more overall coordination and website maintenance.
- Treasurer minor impact; few additional checks to pay, few additional less to pay.
- Uniforms minor impact; three additional Exeter BR All-Star team uniforms

Jeff and I have talked about this at length over the past couple weeks and agree that this is the best option for our BR kids. It eliminates our reliance on the Great Bay organization which has been very unstable. And it puts us in control of the BR experience for our kids.

The reason I'm talking to you about this now is because Jeff needs to meet with the other BR teams to let them know of the change and to get them on board. If anyone has any opposition to this plan please let me know."

Motion to absorb Babe Ruth into EJBL by Tom, 2nd Andy. All in favor with no abstentions.

Open items/new business: Brian asked what we should pay umpires this year: 70' - \$52.50, 60' - \$45, unpatched - \$25. Bob brought up changing our name, postponing until after the season to

see how softball goes. Tom inquired about new field in East Kingston: Todd stated field is in great shape, fence installation was postponed due to snow but should be in week of 3/19. Andy brought up paying board president a stipend for all the work that is required of them. Other boards do this. Item tabled until next meeting due to time.
