We have started preparing for the upcoming 2020 season. Cayuga Youth Athletic Association is based in the City of Niagara Falls with 3 baseball diamonds at 91st Street Park and 4 baseball/softball diamonds and two T-ball diamonds at our 93rd Street facility. New for 2020 Cayuga has acquired through a lease with the City of Niagara Falls 6.7 acres of property adjacent to our current 11.6 acres. With this additional property we will be adding 2 Baseball Diamonds and some additional parking. The Lease is for 30 years. Due to the quality of our programs, CYAA has grown to become the largest all volunteer baseball/softball organization in the local area. We have served over 400 boys and girls, ages 4 to 19, from the City of Niagara Falls the Towns of Wheatfield, Lewiston, Niagara; Grand Island and the Sanborn area. We also have The Boys Heat Travel Baseball and The Gamblers Travel Softball which is part of Cayuga Youth Athletic Association.

Each year we ask our community members and business owners for sponsorships so that we may continue to provide our children safe, structured baseball and softball programs. Listed below are some of the ways your money helps the organization.

- Teams (approx 45 teams) play a 16 game regular season schedule plus a minimum of 2 playoff games in all divisions. In addition to our utilizing our volunteers, we also pay for umpires where necessary.
- Players receive complete Major League replica uniforms (hat, shirt, socks, & pants) for all divisions. Trophies for players in our youth divisions.
- Quality Coaches with experience in baseball/softball and a willing to work with children in their development.
- Opening Day & season ending picnics for players and their families.
- Development of Players through new & exciting programs in our Tee-Ball and Rookie Divisions.
- Top Notch Playing Fields.
- Safety is our #1 priority. We purchase protective helmet cages, pitching machines for the younger players and netting for the fans protection just to name a few.

We completed the construction of senior diamond at the 93rd Street complex. In addition to the new diamond, we also put up new fencing, safety nets, improved the concession stand, added cash registers, purchased lawn mowers, just to name a few.
