





RC College Showcase - Making Headlines

Our August College Showcase was featured in a recent SILive article.

In case you missed it, here's what they had to say.

It's that time of year again.

The Richmond County Baseball Club hosted its annual showcase at its Travis Ave. complex last month. The event offered 80 local players an opportunity to put their baseball skills on display in front of college scouts and recruiters at all levels. All three NCAA divisions, as well as Junior College, were represented.

More than 20 colleges were in attendance in total, including Princeton, St. John's, CSI, Rutgers, and others. Players received two days of coaching and evaluation from the college coaches.

"It's a win-win situation," said RCBC director Nick DeFendis, who runs the program along with George Quinn. "Our players get invaluable instruction from experts at the next level, as well as a number of players being recruited to play college baseball." DeFendis highlighted current Monsignor Farrell shortstop Rob Rispoli, who is committed to UConn, as well as former St. Joseph-by-the-Sea outfielder Jackson Tucker, who now plays for St. John's, as success stories. Both players are RCBC products who benefitted from the showcase, according to DeFendis. "This showcase recently led many other players on to the college level," acknowledged Quinn, who noted RCBC alum Ricky DeVito and Anthony Prato went on to the professional ranks after securing D-I offers.

For regional recruiters, it's an opportunity to get eyes on Staten Island talent on a Staten Island diamond. "This event has been on my recruiting calendar every year and it will continue to be on the calendar for the coming years," noted Seton Hall assistant coach Giuseppe Papaccio. "It gives the (RCBC) program and other local players a chance to be seen by the best schools in the area."

Rutgers University director of baseball operations Pete Barron referred to the event as "first class", while St. John's assistant Danny Bethea reiterated the sentiment. "We've developed a great relationship (with RCBC) because it has always been about player development and passion for the game," said Bethea. "The RCBC showcase has always put out a first class product and they consistently put the best interest of the player first and go above and beyond to get them exposure to college coaches of all levels."

The event has taken place annually for the past decade and next year will be no different, according to its organizers. "It's a special time for us, this is our World Series," concluded DeFendis. "Baseball is alive and well here on Staten Island."


