

Duties and Responsibilities of the BOARD OF DIRECTORS (voting members)

PRESIDENT

The President, as chief officer, is charged with the overall administration and executive function of the Association. He/she shall be the official delegate to the NTSSA meetings. He/She shall appoint such committees, as he/she deems necessary to carry out such functions. He/she shall assign duties to all officers as required. Assignment and acceptance or rejection of duties will be recorded in the meeting minutes. As chief officer, the President is empowered to take prudent and reasonable action in cases not covered by these BY-LAWS, and such authority is implicit in the office. He/She shall report to the Executive Board at Regular Meetings regarding current activities, programs, developments, etc. that affect the association.

He/She shall serve as the back-up, replacement, or second as required, for all other Board members. For example, liaison with the city in place of the League Commissioner, or for instance signing guest player releases for the Registrar; whenever that Board member is unable or unavailable to perform his/her duties.
