5. NEW BUSINESS

(a) 2011 Game Schedule

The Statistician presented the 2011 Schedule. Time was allowed for teams to consult and make changes to the schedule with other teams. Changes were submitted to Statistician Anderson.

(b) All-Star Game

Secretary Anderson noted two proposals for the Senior Game: 1) play East/West divisional, 2) North Dufferin Stars versus outside opponent. Todd Patton (New Lowell) indicated by email Port Hope and Kendal were interested.

Teams decided to play East/West format due to number of teams in the League.

Junior teams will participate in their own game with an outside opponent. Mike Renzetti (Bolton Jr.) will look for an opponent. Decision to be made by early June.

Senior game will be played at 1 p.m. with Junior game following at 4 p.m. on July 10, 2011 at Lisle.

(c) Awards Night

David Anderson provided a synopsis of the Awards Event Survey results from the League website.

(e) Players' Lists Forms

Players' Lists are to be completed and filed with the Secretary seven days prior to the May 25 meeting.

(f) Player's Release Forms

Secretary Anderson indicated proper player release procedure, including forms must be signed and dated prior to a player playing for a new team and a copy be filed with the League by the Roster Meeting (May 25), by mail or hand delivery.

(g) Player Qualification for Playoffs

Statistician Anderson indicated Senior players must play in eight regular season games to qualify for playoffs. Junior players must play in six regular season games to qualify for playoffs.
