

Smith Captures Batting Crown

Bittersville outfielder wins Susquehanna Baseball league batting title with mark of .438. Chronister of Springvale tops pitchers.

Richard Smith, hard hitting outfielder of the Bittersville nine, captured the batting championship of the Susquehanna Baseball league with a mark of .438, according to final batting statistics released yesterday by Charles N. Bahn, league secretary.

Smith clubbed out 25 hits in 57 times at bat to capture the batting trophy. Smith was awarded the trophy at the league's recent post-season banquet, which marked the end of the league's initial season.

In the pitching department, S. Chronister of Springvale topped the field with 11 wins and one defeat for a mark of .917. It was largely through Chronister's efforts that Springvale dominated the loop, winning both first place and playoffs honors.

Emenheiser of Freysville was runnerup in the hurling records, with seven wins and two defeats for a .778 per centage.

McKeesport Contingent To Lead Miami In Game Against Pitt. Played Against York

Pittsburgh, Oct. 25 (AP) — The University of Pittsburgh football team will meet opposition in the stands as well as on the field when it plays Miami university in Pitt stadium Saturday.

That's because a big contingent of rooters from nearby McKeesport will be pulling for the Florida eleven: From 5,000 to 10,000 McKeesporters are shifting their allegiance for this one game.

They are coming to cheer the five McKeesporters on the Hurricanes first team.

Even the star of the Miami team is a McKeesporter. He is 146-pound Jack Hackett, who calls signals and leads in tossing forward passes. Another McKeesporter is the team's leading ground gainer. That's Frank Smith, who has been averaging 6.3 yards per try.

and Dimaggio will conduct baseball clinics and Joe will give exhibitions of long distance clouting.

The Panthers, who have lost four straight games, will be playing a powerful team which has won all four games so far this season.

The Miami team is known for its tight defense. And its power on the ground will provide a stiff test for Pitt.

Miami has had only one forward pass intercepted this year while intercepting 15. Pitt has stolen seven passes but has had 14 pilfered.

The Hurricanes have scored four touchdowns through the air while their opponents have been unable to score on passes. Pitt has turned the trick four times but opponents have scored 11 times on forward passes.

The Floridians rolled to 687 yards on the ground while holding opponents to 334. Pitt has made 354 yards rushing but their opponents have made 555 yards.

Pitt officials say the big ticket

sale for the game is in McKeesport.

Even Mayor Charles Kinkaid will be in the McKeesport contingent. A crowd of 30,000 is expected.

Hackett, although he failed to score, was the star for McKeesport when they met and defeated York High at Small Athletic field three years ago. Also appearing in that game were Frank Smith, Elmer Tremont and Jacky Payne, now regulars on the Miami team.
