A note about the weather: We will still play with light rain. The city will close the fields for severe rain or flooding.

Check-in Procedures for ALL TEAMS:

The check-in tent is located by the restroom/snack bar area. Look for the red Boost tent. Opening Day is a random game assignment, therefore, your schedule will be distributed at check-in. Teams may check-in at the earliest, one hour before the scheduled division start time. Please do not try to check-in early.

ALL TEAMS MUST CHECK-IN TO RECEIVE THEIR GAME ASSIGNMENTS. You may have a coach or AD check-in. The whole team does NOT need to come to the check-in table.

- 1. Turn in missing paperwork. Any player packets that were redlined at registration may be updated and added back to the roster at check-in.
- 2. Add new players with proper paperwork by handwriting them at the bottom of the roster (before approaching the table).
 - a. Player Contract (front and back) 2 copies (one for Boost, one for coach)
 - b. Headshot
 - c. Proof of Age Document
 - d. Boost Waiver
- 3. Mark absent players with an "A", and get the roster signed off by Stacie or Boost Staff.
- 4. Receive your field and game time assignments.

For Opening Day ONLY 7on7 Game Info:

- 20-minute running clock
- 5 minutes between games
- No time outs
- 3 game minimum
- Games cannot end in a tie

Important Notes:

• All players must have soft helmets and mouthpieces to participate. No exceptions.

- Coaches must have a copy of the red roster and all players contracts with them on the field at ALL times.
- A copy of the rule book is attached to this email for your reference.
- The Citrus Park site map is attached to this email, please review the field numbers ahead of time. I also recommend sharing it with parents.

Important Reminders:

- All games run on schedule, on the clock. Please communicate to your parents the site map so they can be prepared to move fields swiftly and know where to go. If you have back to back games, 5 minutes can go by fast!
- The best practice is to have athletes stay with the coach so they can get to their next field and be ready for the coin toss.
- We expect all players, coaches, and parents to contribute to respectable conduct and sportsmanship. No profanity and no fighting. Coaches are responsible for their own sidelines.
