The B.B.A is committed to providing a safe basketball playing environment for all of our participants that emphasizes fair play and good sportsmanship. In addition, we are guests in the schools and must respect the property and rules so we can maintain the privilege of utilizing their facilities.

The B.B.A. has developed a **Code of Conduct** which is designed to ensure that we accomplish the above through the cooperation and support of the parents and/or guardians of our program participants.

We seek your cooperation and support on the following:

- Children not playing in games must be supervised at all times
- Siblings should <u>not</u> attend practices
- Access to the schools is limited to the gym and areas adjacent to the gym
- No running or ballplaying in the halls, stage area, classrooms
- We must respect the property both inside and outside of our schools

Each coach will be given a schedule to fill out. That schedule will include the team's game times. The B.B.A. expects each team to identify an adult hall monitor for each game, and report this information to the B.B.A. before the first game. The named adult will be required to monitor the school during the game.

Every game will provide two adult monitors so each game monitor need only miss one-half of the game to their supervisory responsibilities. If a parent cannot monitor on their assigned day, they must find a replacement for their designated time slot.

The B.B.A. needs your help in establishing and maintaining an environment that will promote fair play, team spirit, respect and good sportsmanship. *Please:*

- Bring your children to games and practices on time
- Communicate to your coach if your child will be unable to attend a practice or game
- Support and encourage <u>all</u> players; **cheer don't jeer**, and please don't' coach from the bleachers
- Do not criticize players, coaches or referees
