 The AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is located in the football storage shed on the shelf behind the backboard

EMERGENCY DURING GAMES

- The Athletic Trainer or the EMT will notify the public address announcer to call 911 Kirk Parker Football Field at Memorial Field, 85 School Street
- Two (2) people from the concession stand will obtain the ambulance entrance gate key (located in the concession stand, by the light switches) and proceed to unlock the gate and wait to direct the ambulance onto the playing field
- An assistant coach will move the team away from the injured player
- If the injured players parents are not present the head coach will notify them by using the contact information in his coaches book
- If no parent is available to ride with the ambulance, a coach will ride with the injured player to the hospital and bring the medical release form for that player from the coaches book

EMERGENCY DURING PRACTICE

- Coaches will assess the injury and determine the extent of the injury
- An assistant coach will move the team away from the injured player
- If non-life threatening or no ambulance is needed, the assistant coaches shall render first aid as the head coach contacts the parents using the contact information in his coaches book
- If an ambulance is needed, a designated coach will call 911 Kirk Parker Football Field at Memorial Field, 85 School Street
- If the injured players parents are not present the head coach will notify them by using the contact information in his coaches book
- If no parent is available to ride with the ambulance, a coach will ride with the injured player to the hospital and bring the medical release form for that player from the coaches book
