FOOTBALL: Glendora falls to Los Osos, 38-21

RANCHO CUCAMONGA - Los Osos forced five Glendora turnovers on Friday and went on to rout the Tartans 38-21 in a Baseline League contest at Los Osos High.

The final score didn't show Los Osos' complete domination in the game. The Grizzlies (4-3 overall, 1-1 league) had a 28-7 edge in first downs and a 438-176 edge in total yards.

Los Osos turned the ball over just once.

Los Osos' offense was led by Cody Regina, who rushed 26 times for 185 yards and three firsthalf touchdowns. Regina did not have a carry in the game's final 17 minutes.

Los Osos dominated the first half statistically but not on the scoreboard. Thanks to Demetrius Hicks' 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown. Glendora (4-3, 0-2) trailed just 21-14 at the half.

"We felt we were right in it," Glendora coach Mark Pasquarella said. "We just needed to get a couple of (defensive) stops."

Glendora's fortunes got even bleaker in the

second half when Chad Jeffries, their starting quarterback, was knocked out of the game in the third quarter.

"We think it might be a collarbone, but we'll know more this week," Pasquarella said.

Jeffries completed 4 of 9 passes for 55 yards, with one touchdown and one interception.
