

FOOTBALL: Glendora beats Lynwood with aerial attack

LYNWOOD - Glendora High School started slow, but Chad Jeffries made sure the Tartans didn't continue in that mode Friday night.

The senior quarterback, who has committed to play at San Diego State, threw for 208 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Tartans to a 33-21 victory over Lynwood in a nonleague game at Lynwood Middle School.

Glendora, which also got 73 yards receiving and two TDs from Dillon Downard, improved to 4-1. Lynwood slipped to 1-3.

"We were a little skeptical about how our kids would respond after last week (a loss to West Covina)," Glendora coach Mark Pasquarella said. "We had a couple of turnovers to start, but then we got our passing game going with Chad."

Jeffries, after the Tartans fell behind 6-0 in the first quarter, sparked the Tartans to a 19-6 lead by halftime following TD passes of 22 and 18 yards to Downard and a 41-yard strike to Charles Johnson with 1:47 left in the half.

Jeffries then made it 26-6 early in the third quarter with an 11-yard pass to Johnson. Jacob Rodriguez returned an interception 95 yards to make it 33-6 with 2:14 left in the quarter.

Lynwood's Julius Childs made it 33-21 on a 38-yard reception and a 1-yard run to make it 33-21.
