At BYU

SENIOR - (2008-2009): Final player notes: started in all games ... named Honorable Mention All-MWC ... team co-captain ... recorded her 11th double figure game with a team-high 15 points at UNLV on 3/10/09 at the 2009 MWC Champs., marking her 31st double digit output of her career ... had three steals in the home win vs. UNLV on 2/21/09 tying her season high in this category, and has had two other games where she's gotten three steals, at Long Beach St., on 12/20/08 and vs. Oregon on 11/21/08 grabbed eight boards at CSU on 2/11/09 for the third time this year ... scored a team high 16 points vs. CSU on 1/10/09, marking her eighth double figure outing of the year and 28th overall ... had four straight double digit point performances with the 16 vs. Weber St., on 12/10/08 which brought her season and career double digit scoring total to six and 26 respectively ... contributed 13 points in the win over USC marking her fifth double figure game this year and 25th overall ... finished ranked second on the team in points with 9.8 per game and tied for third place on the team in rebounds grabbing 4.0 boards per game ... was the team leader in points in a total of eight games on the year ... and topped or tied the list in rebounds in six contests on the year ... ended her senior season ranked second in three categories on the team: field goals attempted (10.3); field goals made with a total of 113 for a 3.9 average, and in offensive boards with a total of 53 for a 1.8 average ... on the team ranked third in three categories: three-point field goals attempted with 86 for a 3.0 average; in free throws attempted with 48 on the year and a 1.7 average; steals with a total of 32 ... in three other categories places fifth: field goal percentage .377, 113-300; three-point field goal percentage .326, 28-86; defensive rebounds with 63 total for a 2.2 average ... had a total of 11 blocked shots which ranks her fourth on the team ... recorded her third double digit performance



of the year with a season high 18 points vs. SUU on 11/28/08 ... had a team and game high 17 points in the home opener vs. Oregon on 11/21 ... had back-to-back double digit performances with 15 @ Portland St., on 11/14/08 and the 17 vs. Oregon ... in the MWC ranked 22nd in scoring in all games (9.8) points and in league games placed 27th (7.9), also finishes the season in 15th place in the offensive rebound category in all games grabbing 1.83 boards per contest.

JUNIOR - (2007-2008): Final player notes: started in all games ... in league action finished ranked 28th in scoring (7.4), and 16th in rebounding (5.5) per game, as well as 14th in defensive rebounds (3.83)in the TCU game on 3/8/08 picked up her third career double double with game highs in points (20) and in rebounds (10), her point total marked her second best and 20th double digit contest in her career, ninth this year and fifth in MWC action ... the 20 points in the TCU game on 3/8/08 marked season highs as did the eight field goals made ... led the team in total points scored in six games, grabbed team highs in rebounds in eight games, dished out team highs in assists in four games and in steals in three contests ... scored 10 points at AF on 3/1/08 for her 19th career, eighth season and fourth in MWC action ... picked up her 18th career and seventh season double figure game with 11 points at UNLV on 2/16/08 ... in the home victory over CSU on 2/13/08 tallied her 17th career and sixth season double digit contest with a team and game high 14 points ... ranks second on the team in points and in rebounds with 7.4 points and 5.5 boards per contest ... grabbed 12 boards in the contest against No.15 Wyoming on 2/2/08 for new season and career highs ... in the road game at UNM on 1/26/08 scored 12 points marking her 16th career double digit game, her fifth of the year and her first in MWC play ... grabbed 11 rebounds vs. New Mexico St. on 12/5/07 ... tallied 10 points vs. UCLA on 12/15/07 for her 15th career double figure game and the fourth this season ... finished her junior season in second place in a total of six categories: three-point field goals attempted 92 (3.2) and made 27 (0.9), field goal attempted .258 (8.9), in total rebounds 160 (5.5), offensive boards with 49 (1.7) and defensive boards 111 (3.8) ... ended the year third in two stat categories: field goals made with 89 (3.1), and in steals 25 (0.9) ... placed fifth in three-point field goal percentage .293 (17-58) and eighth in field goal percentag

SOPHOMORE - (2006-2007): Final player notes: Played in all games starting in the first seven ... ranks third in scoring and in rebounds with 7.8 points and 4.5 boards per game ... finished ranked third on the team in total rebounds with 150, third in both offensive and defensive rebounds with a total of 46 and 104 respectively ... ranked in fourth place in both assists with a total of 69 for a 2.1 average and in steals with a total of 35 for a 1.1 average ... is second on the team in field goal attempts (8.7) average and fourth in field goals made (3.1) average ... in the MWC Champs., game vs. UNM picked up her 10th game scoring in double digits with 14 ... in the game vs. TCU tallied her ninth double figure game ... she had three back to back double figure games with (13) at the AFA game on 01/06/07, (16) at UNM on 01/10/07, and (11) vs. Wyoming on 01/13/07 ... picked up a new season and career high four three-pointers in a game @ UNM on 1/10/07 ... in the league game vs. TCU on 02/01/07 picked up a new season high in assists with five ... had a season and career high four steals vs. AF on 01/06/07 ... notched her second season and career double double with 22 points and 10 rebounds vs. SCU on 11/22/06, the 22 points in that game were new season and career high ... also in that game went .916 (11-12) from the free throw line, a new season and career best ... picked up first career and season double double with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. ISU on 11/10/06 ... in the same game had her first career start, and the 10 rebounds are a new career high ... named MWC Player of the Week on 11/10/06 for her achievements in the ISU game.

FRESHMAN - (2005-2006): Final player notes: placed fifth on the team in offensive rebounds with a total of 27 for a 0.8 average ... ranked fifth in three-point field goal percentage with .353 (6-17) ... was sixth in the free-throw percentage category with .724 (21-29) ... finished seventh in both points and points average with a total of 103 points for a 3.2 average ... was 11th on the squad in field goal percentage with .376 (38-101) ... played in all games ... picked up season and career highs in points 10, and in rebounds 9 vs. TCU on 2/24/06 ... dished out a season and career high four assists at SDSU on 2/22/06 ... tallied nine points all on treys in the game vs. UNLV on 01/14/06 ... had seven points vs. Portland on 12/30/05 ... picked up four points @ Seton Hall on 12/03/05 ... scored a three-pointer at the buzzer to end the first half of action @ UCLA on 11/22/05 to give BYU a six-point 35-29 lead going into the locker room.
