2007-08: Evans-Sluga saw action in 27 games ... averaged 5.4 points per game in 8.4 minutes ... made her Bobcat scoring debut against Concordia (11/23) to set a career-high eight points ... erased the mark with five other double-digit scoring occasions ... went 6-for-12 from the field and 5-for-7 from three point range to post a 17-point season-high mark against McNeese State (2/14) ... other double-digit tallies came against Huston Tillotson, 15, backed by 13 points against Baylor (1/04) ... final two-digit scoring night was produced against Stephen F. Austin ... went 5-for-8 from the field and 4-for 5 from three-point range with three rebounds for 14 points ... averaged 1.3 rebounds per game ... career-high five boards came against SW Assemblies (12/12) ... shot 78.9 percent from the free throw line, going 15-for-19 on the season ... recorded five steals.

Salt Lake Community College: As a freshman, averaged 9.2 points per game in only 15.4 minutes a game at SLCC playing for Coach Betsy Specketer ... 10.3 points and 2.3 rebounds in three games ... Red-shirted the remainder of sophomore year due to injury ... 04-05 SWAC All-Conference All-Academic selection.

Taylorsville HS: Averaged 18 points and five rebounds playing for Coach Jace Hymas at Taylorsville High School her senior year ... Three-time All-Region and two time All-State selections ... Named Team MVP...Selected to 5A All-Star Game ... National Scholar Athlete Award.
