

## Majors 65


D. Majors 65 .

1. Time Limits: All games have a two hour time limit. No new innings to start after two hours during the weekdays. No new innings after 1:45 on Saturdays
2. Score and standings are kept in this division.
3. Continuous batting order and all players will play a minimum of 3 innings in the field if it's a completed game.
4. Players will be rotated as directed to different positions. 9 players with 3 outfielders will be on the field at the same time.
5. No child shall play the same position more than 3 innings per game, except pitcher, when complying with pitch count rules. Every child must start once a week.
6. Strike zone is inside of chalk to inside of chalk, knees to letters. The batter can strikeout, walk or take a base if hit by pitch. Dropped third strike rule applies. If a runner walks toward the dugout outside the clay the batter is out.
7. A team's at bat consists of three (3) outs or five runs, whichever comes first.
8. The pitching distance shall be set at 46 feet. EBYA pitch count rules apply. A pitcher who delivers more than 41 or more pitches in a game is NOT allowed to play catcher for the remainder of the day
9. Leading off and stealing is allowed (open basses). Baulks can be called, first offense is a warning, on the second offense, the runner will advance. Base runners must avoid contact and are limited to feetfirst sliding except to avoid pick off.
10) 1 plate umpire will be provided. Managers will be responsible for making the calls in the field in a fair and sportsmanlike manor.
11.. 5 run limit, ties permitted
12.. A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game can't play catcher for the remainder of the day.
13.. Courtesy runner is allowed for pitcher and catcher. That courtesy runner will be the last recorded out and only if there are 2 outs.
14.. The Manager is responsible for fulfilling umpiring duty as scheduled and shall recruit qualified replacement(s), if unable to umpire as scheduled. Failure to umpire as scheduled shall result in a manager suspension of first offense: one (1) game. Second offense: suspended for the remainder of the season, subject to review of the Board.
15. There will be a end of the year tournament to crown a champion. Teams will play 2 pool play games and then advance to a single elimination bracket. Rules for seeding our as follows.
1) win loss record
2) fewest runs allowed
3)highest run differential
3) runs scored
