B. Rookie.

- 1. Time Limits: All games have a two hour time limit. No new innings to start after two hours during the weekdays. No new innings after 1:45 on Saturdays.
- 2. Score is kept in this division.
- 3. Continuous batting order and all players will play a minimum of 3 innings in the field if game is completed.
- 4. Players will be rotated as directed to different positions. 10 players with 4 outfielders will be on the field at the same time. The outfielders must remain in the grass.
- 5. No child shall play the same position more than 2 innings per game. Every child must start once a week. Every child playing outfield one inning per game is highly encouraged.
- 6. Coaches (2) may be beyond the clay in foul outfield territory on defense to assist players. When batting, coaches may occupy the coaching boxes.
- 7. A team's at bat consisting of three (3) outs or five runs, whichever comes first.
- 8. Pitching machine will be used throughout the season. The machine should be set 46 feet from home plate, the speed should be set at 35-40 MPH. Each batter will be given 5 pitches or three swinging strikes before striking out. No strike out on a foul ball. The officials of the game can call a "no pitch" on an unhittable pitch if the batter does not swing. The starting speed for spring will be 35 MPH which should be 6 or 7 depending on the machine.(games 1-7) The rest of the season, the speed should be 40 MPH which should be between 8 and 10 depending on the machine.
- 9. Bunting is allowed, fake bunting is not.
- 10. No base stealing.
- 11. Runners may advance until the ball is in the control of an infielder and time has been granted by the officials. Runners may advance 1 base on an overthrow per play.
- 12. Umpires are not provided for this division. Coaches from both teams officiate in a cooperative and sportsman-like fashion.

- 13. 5 run limit per inning, ties permitted.
- 14) Teams will compete in a end of the season tournament. Teams will play 2 pool play games then advance to a single elimination bracket. Rules for seeding as is follows.
- 1) win loss record
- 2) fewest runs allowed
- 3) highest run differential
- 5) runs scored
