Now in her 18th season as head coach of the Pioneers,

Erin Monahan has already accomplished more than some coaches achieve in an entire career. The Monahan led Pioneers have made eight NCAA tournament appearances, twice advancing to the Elite Eight and once to the Sweet 16. Her Pioneers have won a New Jersey Athletic Conference championship, while she has collected five NJAC "Coach of the Year" awards.

As player turned coach, Monahan understands the demands of being a collegiate athlete. She enjoyed a successful playing career as a forward for the Pioneers, finishing her career with 1,025 points, and graduating with a degree in exercise and movement science in 1991.



Jill Bachonski
Assistant Coach

Jill has coached at all levels of basketball with both girls and boys.

One of her best assets is her ability to work with players during practices.

She can play them one on one, encourage strengths and help correct weaknesses.

One of the most celebrated players in Pioneers history, Bachonski starred from 1989-93 and helped the program win its first ever New Jersey Athletic Conference Championship in 1993 by scoring 34 points in the championship game. Her 1279 points rank seventh all-time and were good enough for her to be inducted into the William Paterson Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.
