

HALLIE COHEN

The 20th-year Pioneer coach has led William Paterson to 16 consecutive winning seasons, including NJAC and NCAA Tournament East Regional titles and a National Ranking of seventh in 2005. Cohen has guided the Pioneers to seven NCAA tournament appearances and four NJAC crowns overall. She is the most successful coach in the Pioneer program's history with 484 victories, and she ranks among the top 10 active coaches in Division III with her 679 career wins. A Division I athlete, who played with the original "Budweiser Belles" in the late '70's, Cohen was the first female athlete to be offer a full scholarship to Rutger's University for field hockey and softball. She guided the Scarlet Knights to their first and only appearance in the NCAA National Tournament.

VANESSA LENOIR

Lenoir's presence has been invaluable in the development of catchers such as two-time All-American Morgan Dunlap (2001-2002). A William Paterson alumna ('94) who played for the Pioneers from 1990-93, she was a three-time all-NJAC catcher who earned all-region accolades. Lenoir ranks fifth on William Paterson's career home runs list (10). A full-time employee of the University, Lenoir is the Asst. Director in the Registrar's Office on campus.

CAROL KASHOW

Kashow coached with the professional New York/New Jersey Juggernauts and owns 24 years of Division I coaching experience (12 seasons at Drexel, and 6 each at Penn and Temple). She is currently the Athletic Director at John Jay College of Criminal Justice in New York City. A Division I athlete, who graduated with a Health and Physical Education degree from West Chester State University, and now stands in their Hall of Fame for both softball and badminton. Kashow has been an international field hockey official, and continues to officiate on the collegiate level now.

KATHY MAY HILL

Kathy May played for the Pioneers from 1989-92. She was the first player from William Paterson to earn All-American honors. She was selected to the All-American 2nd team in 1990, as well as All-Conference, and the All-NCAA Tournament Teams and now stands in the record books for single season hitting record, batting .455 and collecting 56 hits. She was inducted into the WPU "Hall of Fame" in 1999. Has served as an assistant coach for the Pioneers for the last 4 years.
