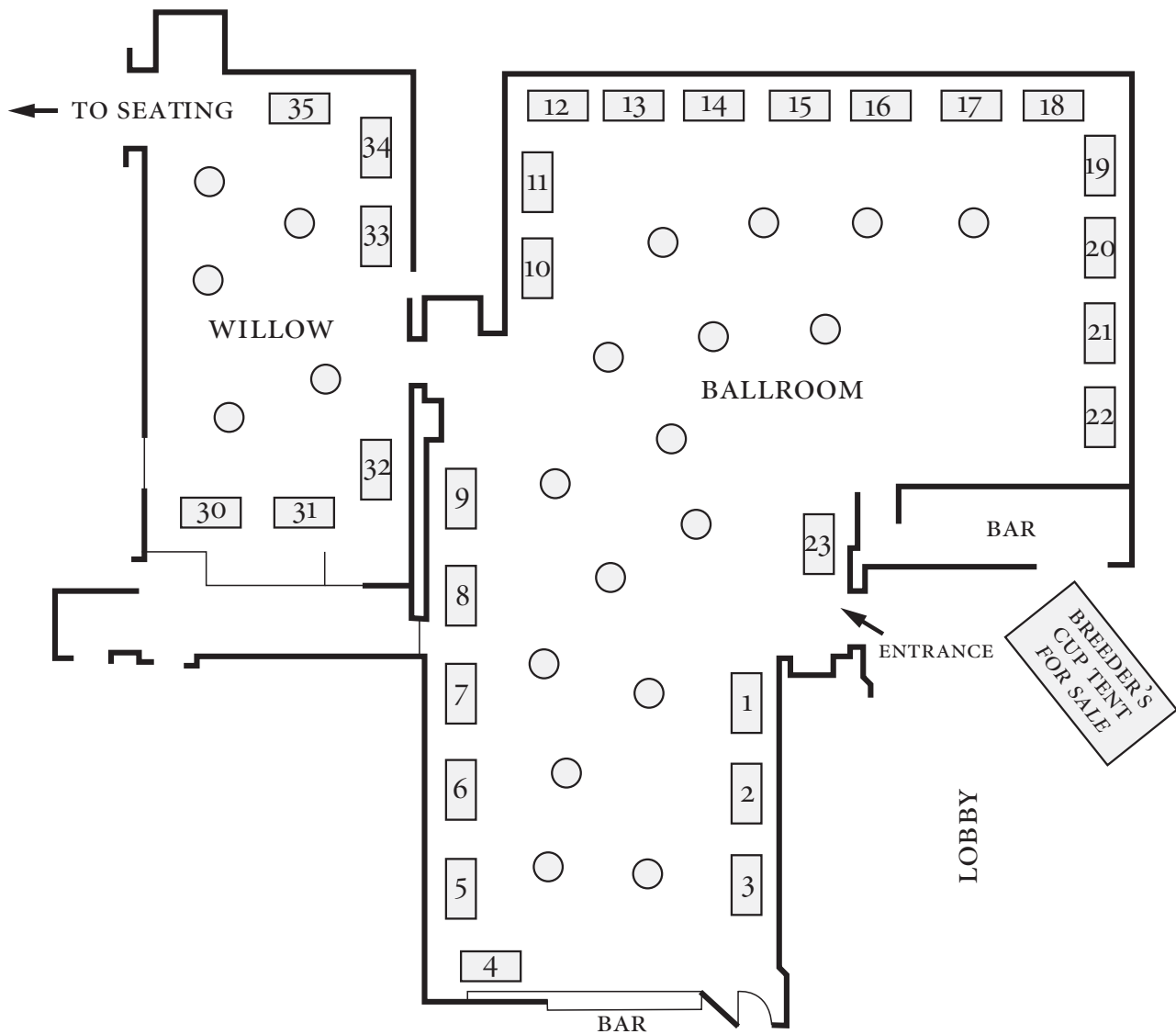

Since its inception, the Oceanport Sports Foundation has been committed to improving the quality of youth recreational sports within the Borough of Oceanport. Fundraising by the OSF members has had an appreciable impact upon the recreational facilities enjoyed by the residents of Oceanport.

When the 2007 Breeders Cup World Championships came to Monmouth Park Race Track, the OSF hosted a Charity Polo Match as part of the Breeders Cup Fan Fest Events...followed by a second Charity Polo match in 2008. As a by-product of these two events, the soccer fields at Maria Gatta Park were given a much needed makeover. The fields at Maria Gatta Park to this day are in far better condition due to the joint efforts of our own Department of Public Works and the many volunteers of the Sports Foundation and it's corporate sponsors.

Since it's inception, The Oceanport Sports Foundation has granted funds in an amount approaching \$100,000 to a variety of programs and organizations all within the Borough of Oceanport.
