 - a. Signups are available online (player, coach, and sponsor)
 - b. Registration flyers (1700 total) were distributed at Purvis Lower, Upper, Middle, Baxterville, and Lamar Christian Schools.
2. Outstanding obligations. Balance as of 1/15: \$4,200
 - a. Concrete: \$3,500
 - b. Fence: \$20,250
 - c. Agri-AFC: \$2,000
 - d. Blocks: \$850
3. Vote on providing portable mounds for fields 1, 2, and 3 during 2013 season, pending funds availability. (Yea / Nay)
 - a. Fields 1 & 2: ~\$2,800/ea
 - b. Field 3: ~\$3,400
 - c. Total: ~\$9,000 for all three fields
4. Vote on Landscaping in front of park by Water Flow. Quote is for area between fields 1, 2, and 3 and the paved parking area. Includes: 10 pallets Bermuda sod, 1-plant row behind bleachers, 2-plant rows behind dugouts. All plants 3-gallon size. Material cost alone is ~\$4,500, Total quote ~\$7,000

7. Field duty work to be completed: *(items in **RED** need to be completed prior to practices)*
 - a. Backstops (in-progress)
 - b. Landscaping
 - c. Remove lip from infield (outfield side) on field 2
 - d. Build mounds up on all 3 fields
 - e. Fix movable rubber issue from girls field (gets stuck)
 - f. Buildup infield on field 2
 - g. Build steps for press box field 2 and field 3
 - h. Seal holes in wall in concession stand
 - i. Add lighting to bathrooms (Completed by Richard D.)
 - j. Fix mens urinal step-up and water issues as well as drain
 - k. Small window air conditioners in restrooms
 - l. Rebuild porch looking onto field 2
 - m. Re-position field lights and replace bad bulbs (need Casey truck)
 - n. Replace bad bulbs on scoreboards
 - o. Install "Purple backing" on CF fences
 - p. Edge all fields
 - q. Block work on sidewalk leading to girls field (completed 1/12/13)
 - r. Fix drainage issue under sidewalk at batting cages
 - s. Paint safety steps on new concrete
 - t. Build curb to prevent traffic close to girls field and to redirect water away from field
 - u. Paint all structures
 - v. Install industrial grade auto door closer on concession door (Completed by Richard D.)
